2,386 students graduated from summer 2015 through spring 2016.

- 1,529 (64%) were transfer program (A.S. & A.A.) graduates
- 637 (75%) were career program (A.A.S.) graduates
- 220 (9%) were certificate program graduates

Highlights:

- 1,709 (72%) are employed and/or are continuing their education
- Of the Career and Certificate Program graduates who are employed full-time, 90% are employed in Monroe or an adjacent county.
- Graduates were hired by 704 different employers
- 69% of the graduates who are continuing their education are doing so at a SUNY/ CUNY institution
