A Total of 2,215 Credentials were Awarded

- 1,365 (62%) were transfer program (A.S. & A.A.) graduates
- 585 (26%) were career program (A.A.S.) graduates
- 265 (12%) were certificate program graduates

Highlights:

- 1,327 (60%) are employed and/or are continuing their education
- Of the Career and Certificate Program graduates who are employed full-time, 91% are employed in Monroe or an adjacent county.
