A Total of 2,278 Credentials were Awarded

- 1,352 (59%) were transfer program (A.S. & A.A.) graduates
- 607 (27%) were career program (A.A.S.) graduates
- 319 (14%) were certificate program graduates

Highlights:

- 1,530 (67%) are employed and/or are continuing their education
- Of the career and certificate program graduates who are employed full-time, 96% are employed in Monroe or an adjacent county.
- Graduates were hired by 380 different employers
- 68% of the graduates who are continuing their education are doing so at a SUNY/CUNY institution
- Graduates transferred to 139 different colleges

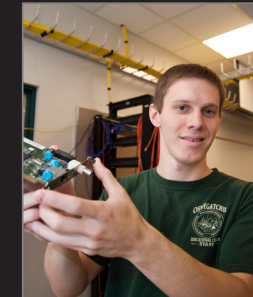
