
What Happened to the Class of 2019?

A Comprehensive Follow-Up Study of MCC Graduates









Class of 2019 Profile

A Total of 1,971 Credentials were Awarded

- 1,228 (62%) were transfer program (A.S. & A.A.) graduates
- 547 (28%) were career program (A.A.S.) graduates
- 196 (10%) were certificate program graduates

Highlights:

- 1,207 (61%) are employed and/or are continuing their education
- Of the career and certificate program graduates who are employed full-time, 93% are employed in Monroe or an adjacent county.
- Graduates were hired by 279 different employers
- 63% of the graduates who are continuing their education are doing so at a SUNY/CUNY institution
- Graduates transferred to 117 different colleges
