Class of 2022 Profile

A Total of 1,610 Credentials were Awarded

- 897 (56%) were transfer program (A.S. & A.A.) graduates.
- 500 (31%) were career program (A.A.S.) graduates.
- 213 (14%) were certificate program graduates.

Highlights

- Of the 396 graduates for whom we have outcome data, 387 (98%) are employed and/or are continuing their education.
- Of the career and certificate program graduates who are employed full-time, 90% are employed in Monroe or an adjacent county.
- Graduates were hired by 69 different employers.
- 81% of the graduates who are continuing their education are doing so at a SUNY/CUNY institution.
- Graduates transferred to 40 different colleges.
