

# What Happened to the Class of 2023?

## Introduction

What Happened to the Class of (WHTCO) 2023 is a Report of a survey with additional data about MCC Graduates. The Class of 2023 includes graduates from July 1st 2022 to June 30th 2023.

## Methodology

The WHTCO is an annual survey which is sent to all students who graduated in the prior year. Graduates are surveyed after 6 months to one year in order to allow time to find a job and/or continue their education at another higher education institution. Response rates are calculated by dividing the number of students who completed at least one question on the survey by the number of students the survey was sent to. Students who open the survey but do not take the survey are not calculated in this figure.

All graduates were sent to the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) to determine if they had any higher education enrollment after their MCC graduation. All colleges who participate in the federal financial aid program are required to report student enrollments in order to determine eligibility for aid, roughly 98% of all colleges report to this agency. NSC returns a file with a record for each semester and school a graduate is enrolled in. Recent graduates can have more than one college in the file. In cleaning the data IR prioritizes 4-year colleges then includes 2 year to create one college for each graduate from the NSC file. Tables 1 to 3 include a column to count how many students have further enrollment for each program. This is regardless of survey response status.

## *Class of 2023 Profile*

- A Total of 1,365 Students Graduated\*
- 796 (58%) were transfer program (A.S. & A.A.) graduates.
- 396 (29%) were career program (A.A.S.) graduates.
- 173 (13%) were certificate program graduates.

\* This is an unduplicated count of graduates, students earning multiple awards within the survey window are counted in the 'higher' category IE Associates instead of Certificate.

Of those 1365 graduates, 233 responded to the WHTCO survey (17% response rate). All graduates were sent to the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC), 706 of which were matched with subsequent enrollment records (52%)

## Highlights

- Of the 812 graduates for whom we have outcome data, 803 (99%) are employed and/or are continuing their education.
- 72% of the graduates who are continuing their education are doing so at a SUNY/CUNY institution.
- CERT and Career (AAS) Grads, 80 have employment data with location. 75% are employed within Monroe County while 87.5% are employed in Monroe and Adjacent counties.
- Transfer (AS and AA) grads, 88 have employment data with location. 71.6% are employed within Monroe County, and 80.7% are employed in Monroe and Adjacent counties.
- 172 graduates are continuing their studies here at MCC (NSC)
- Graduates transferred to 78 different colleges (NSC)

## Outcomes Tables

Tables one through three below show the number of graduates and their outcomes by degree type and program. For each program row, there is the number of graduates, then the number who responded to the survey. Of the survey respondents; Employed and Enrollment numbers include all alumni within those categories. Alumni who selected employed and enrolled are counted in each category. The category of Seeking Job comes from the survey, where respondents selected that survey question option. Seeking is no job and looking for one.

The last column, Enrolled NSC, is the number of graduates with subsequent enrollment verified by the National Student Clearinghouse, this number is any graduate in the NSC return, regardless of survey response status.
