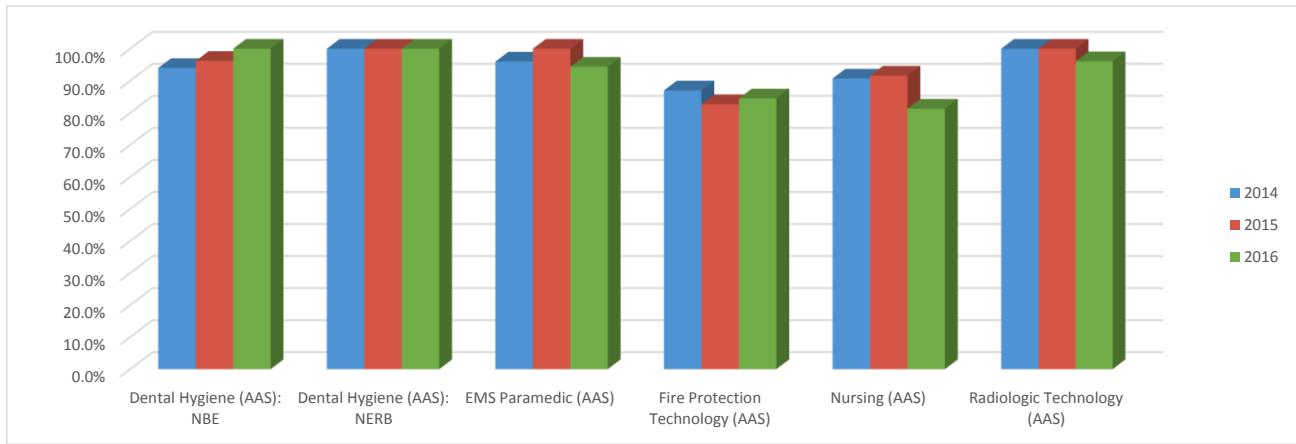


# LICENSURE PASS RATES

The following graph and table show the academic programs in which graduates are required to take a licensing exam in order to work in their field. The following are the academic programs and the licensing exams that graduates must take:

- Dental Hygiene (AAS) - Dental Hygiene National Board Exam ("NBE"), Northeast Regional Boards ("NERB")
- EMS Paramedic (AAS) - New York State Paramedic Exam
- Fire Protection Technology (AAS) - New York State EMT Certification
- Massage Therapy (AAS)\* - Dental Hygiene National Board Exam
- Nursing (AAS) - NCLEX-RN Exam
- Radiologic Technology (AAS) - American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (aka NYS Rad Tech Exam)
- EMS (Certificate) - EMT Certification
