

# Map Student Storage (S-Drive) to Windows

---

NOTE: The information entered for this connection is unique to each student. For this guide we are using the following account as an example.

First Name: Jane

Last Name: Doe

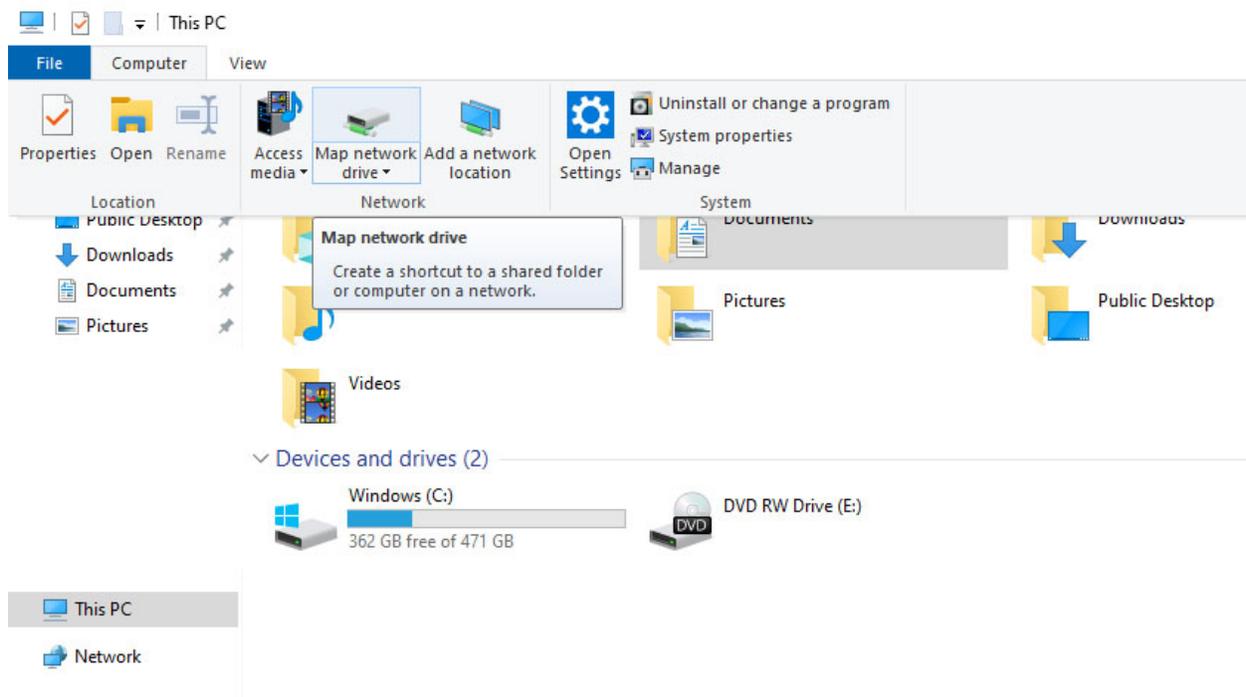
Network Account: jdoe001

Open file explorer by either searching the Windows menu for “File Explorer” or click the icon  from the taskbar.

Click on Computer (upper left) -> Map network drive



On the Map Network Drive dialogue box:

- Choose a drive letter not being used
- Enter the folder path based on the example below.
- Check the box to reconnect at sign-in
- Check the box to connect using different credentials

The folder path for MCC students is

For our Jane Doe example account, the folder path is
