My Courses in myMCC

Many professors require you to use My Courses (also called Blackboard) to access class content, assignments, tests, grades, and instructor email.

Find your courses in the myMCC Students tab under the My Courses sub-tab starting 7 days before classes begin.

M-Drive

Some professors use the M-drive instead of Blackboard. To get to the M-drive:

- From campus computers using Windows Explorer (folders): This PC > Mdrive > Courses, search by course
- Off-campus login to access M-drive • • Learn how to accessing the M-drive from off-campus
- Map the Courses Folder (M Drive) to your computer

Create and Organize Files

Submit assignments in Blackboard as Word, PDF, or PPT files. If using other programs, convert files before submitting. Learn how to convert Google Docs to PDF (Video, 1.5 min.)

Saving Your Work

S-Drive

Save documents on the S-drive to use them from any computer on campus. You'll see folders for each of your courses and for "My Documents." "My Documents" will be backed up as long as your student account is active, so you should move course folders to "My Documents" after each semester. Learn how to map your S-drive to a personal computer.

Flash Drives

If you save your work on a flash drive, eject it properly and keep it in a safe place.

Print Documents Using Papercut



You receive \$15 print credit per semester. Print from any campus computer by logging on to **PaperCut** with your MCC network account and password to release your print jobs. Learn more about printing on campus (including printing from laptops and printing in color)
