- ✓ Must maintain a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.25 or higher.
- ✓ Must hold a minimum of three (3)-office hour per week.
- ✓ Must attend Senate meetings on Tuesdays from 2PM – 5PM.
- ✓ Must attend pre-agenda meetings on Fridays from 12:15 PM – 12:50 PM.
- ✓ Must serve the full length of their term (from selection to Commencement Day).
