

Paper Plane Contest Rules

Your Paper Plane

- Paper planes have to be built on site, 11-204, during the event.
- Paper of various sizes and various weight will be provided.
- Planes must be made using the provided paper.
- Paper can be cut to size as needed. Scissors will be provided.
- Tape, paper clips, staples, pins are not allowed.
- Paper plans can be built using only paper folds.
- Books and instructions will be available. You can also bring your own instructions.
- You can build as many paper planes as you would like, but a maximum of four planes may be flown in the contest.

The Contest

- The plane must be launched by one person throwing the plane unaided from behind a straight launch line marked on the floor. Passing over the launch line leads to an invalid attempt.
- The plane must fly within a designated flight path. Planes leaving the flight path will lead to a disqualified attempt. The attempt will count as one of your 4 attempts.
- Flight distance is measured from the starting line to the furthestmost part of the plane after it has come to rest.
- Everyone must have a turn before you can have your next turn.
- Only the best distance over all your attempts will be counted. Judgement of the game coordinators are final.
