Senator Tran so moved, second by Senator Allen.

Discussion: the 5% increase in the Student Life Fee is to help mitigate some of the expense deficit to ensure and maintain student programs and services for the 2023-2024 academic year.

A vote was taken. The resolution passed.

Be it resolved, the senate present and voting that the MCC Association budget and the 5% increase in the Student Life Fee is supported by the Student Government Association at Monroe Community College.

3. Resolution for the approval of the funding request for Black Student Union

Resolved, the Monroe Community College Student Government Association approves the Black Student Union funding request of \$100 to support their upcoming event.

Vice President Millet called for a motion to approve the resolution.

Senator Joseph so moved, second by Senator Allen.

Discussion: The Black Student Union completed the request fund and met the standards of both the Student Government Association and the Office of Student Life and Leadership.

A vote was taken. The resolution passed.

Be it resolved, by the senate present and voting the Student Government Association allocates \$100 to the Black Student Union at Monroe Community College.

4. Resolution for the approval of the funding request for Campus One80

Resolved, the Monroe Community College Student Government Association approves the Campus One80 funding request of \$3836 to help pay for a trip to their retreat in the Delta Lake Bible Conference.

Vice President Millet called for a motion to approve the resolution.

Senator Tran so moved, second by Senator Allen.

Discussion: Campus One80 completed the request fund and met the standards of both the Student Government Association and the Office of Student Life and Leadership.

A vote was taken. The resolution passed.

Be it resolved, by the senate present and voting the Student Government Association allocates \$3836 to Campus One80 at Monroe Community College.
